MODI, MACRON HOLD TALKS ON BOARD PRESIDENTIAL AIRCRAFT

N-reactors, missiles: India and France deepen ties

Nuclear energy key to energy mix: Joint statement

SHUBHAJIT ROY New Delhi, February 12

INDIA AND FRANCE on Wednesday agreed to jointly develop modern nuclear reactors, boost defence cooperation with procurement of missiles, submarines, engines for aircraft and helicopters, and jointly work on projects in third countries.

These were the outcome of bilateral discussions between Prime Minister Narendra Modi and French President Emmanuel Macron on board the Presidential aircraft while flying from Paris to Marseille.

Describing the decision to travel together on the Presidential aircraft "an exceptional gesture by Macron, emblematic of deep personal trust between the two leaders, and remarkable confidence they have in each other",foreign secretary Vikram Misri said India-France "ties literally touched new heights".

Misri said AI was a "major area" of the discussion, he said. According to the joint state-

ment, Modi and Macron stressed that nuclear energy is essential for bolstering energy security and transitioning towards a low-carbon economy.

Both leaders acknowledged the India-France ties and efforts in cooperation on the peaceful uses of nuclear energy, notably in relation with the Jaitapur nuclear power plant project.

"They welcomed the first meeting of the Special Task Force on Civil Nuclear Energy,

and welcomed the 'signing of a letter of intent on Small ModularReactor(SMR) and Advanced Modular Reactor (AMR)' and the Implementing Agreement between India's GCNEP, DAE and France's INSTN, CEA for cooperation in training and education of nuclear professionals,"it stated.

SMRs are compact nuclear fission reactors that can be manufactured in factories and then installed elsewhere. They have a smaller capacity than conventional nuclear reactors, and are seen as the future of civilian nuclear cooperation.

Going ahead from the AI Action summit in Paris, Modi and Macron also "launched an India-France Roadmap on AI, rooted in the philosophical convergence in their approaches focusing on the development of safe, open, secure and trustworthy artificial intelligence".

Under the theme of "Partnership for Security and Sovereignty", the two leaders recalled the "deep and longstanding defence cooperation", and welcomed the continuation of the cooperation of air and maritime assets in line with the ambitious Defence Industrial Roadmap agreed in 2024.

Both leaders "commended progress in collaboration in construction of Scorpene submarines in India, including indigenisation, and in particular the work carried out with a view to the integration of DRDO-developed Air Independent Propulsion (AIP) into P75-Scorpene submarines and the analyses conducted regarding the possible integration of the Integrated Combat System (ICS) into the future P75-AS submarines."

AHEAD OF HIS meeting with US President Donald Trump in the White House, Prime Minister Narendra Modi met US vice president JD Vance in Paris and discussed how the US can assist India in diversifying its energy sourcing through investments in US nuclear technology. The bilateral meeting took

place before Modi left for the US to meet Trump. The Prime Minister, who left Marseille for Washington DC, will reach early Thursday India time.

Tughlakabad Fort protected area's physical demarcation to be completed in 3 weeks, HC told

NEW DELHI, FEBRUARY 12

AFTER YEARS of stalemate, Kalkaii sub-divisional magistrate (SDM) informed the Delhi High Court on Wednesday that in consultation with the Archeological Survey of India (ASI), physical demarcation of the Tughlakabad Fort protected area shall be completed within three weeks.

This, after the ASI, through its counsel, informed HC that the physical demarcation is yet to be carried out.

A division bench of Chief Justice D K Upadhyaya and Justice Tushar Rao Gedela had on Tuesday pulled up the authorities for the delay in completing the physical demarcation despite the court's repeated orders to remove encroachments from the protected area.

The court has been hearing a bunch of petitions, one dating as far back as to 2001, over the issue of removal of encroachments in Tughlakabad Fort.

Last December, the HC had recorded in its order, "...it is apparent that for one reason or the other, the physical demarcation has not been conducted so far, for past several years, which we consider to be necessary to address the issue of rampant encroachment in the area."

It had asked the SDM as well as the additional director general of ASI to join the proceedings on

the next date of hearing "to assist this court for resolution" of the issue.

Kalkaji SDM Anuj Bharti, appearing before the court on Wednesday, said that he was posted at his current jurisdiction only last November and was thereafter engaged in duties related to the Delhi polls Bharti assured the court that

its order directing for a physical demarcation of the area will be completed. "It won't take much time now, we can get it done in a week... Maps have already been prepared by tehsildar... coordinates are available.'

The bench recorded Bharti's statement, noting that "in consultation with ASI, the physical demarcation of the area shall be completed in three weeks".

The HC will hear the matter next on March 26, when it also directed that a report regarding work done on the matter related to physical demarcation be submitted before the court.

AS MID-FEBRUARY approaches, Delhi has been recording significantly above-normal temperatures for this time of the year.

The temperature has been on the rise, nearing the 30 degree Celsius mark on Tuesday — the warmest day of the season. On Wednesday, the maximum settled at 26.5 degrees Celsius, three degrees above normal.

This follows an exceptionally warm January, the hottest since 2019, with the monthly average temperature climbing to 21.1 degrees Celsius. In 2019, the January average was 21.2 degrees Celsius.

While the maximum temperature in Delhi has been above normal for the past week, the minimum has also been on the rise over the past four days. At 11.6 degrees Celsius, Wednesday's minimum temperature was a notch above normal.

The IMD has forecast strong surface winds during the daytime till Friday. Mist conditions are likely after that.

The night temperature is forecast to rise to 13 degrees Celsius by February 17. During the same period, the maximum is forecast to remain above normal between 27 and 29 degrees Celsius.

Similar to 2022 and 2016, this year too saw no cold wave days in January. Feeble western disturbances have also meant no cold wave days in February so far.

The India Meteorological Department (IMD), in its monthly forecast for February, warned of above-normal temperatures with below-normal rainfall over most parts of the country. It also forecast fewer cold wave days over the northwest plains.

The lack of substantial western disturbances resulted in a deficit in rainfall and snowfall. leading to higher than usual temperatures and impacting air

The Air Quality Index (AQI) has remained in the moderate and poor categories this month so far because of warmer temperatures and strong surface

According to the IMD, the below-normal rainfall, coupled with higher temperatures over the plains of Northwest India in February, is expected to have significant adverse effects on standing crops such as wheat, particularly during the flowering and grain-filling stages.

Crops like mustard and chickpea may also experience early maturity. Horticultural crops like apples and other temperate stone fruits may face premature bud break and early flowering due to the warmer temperatures, resulting in poor fruit setting and quality, which could ultimately affect yield.

To mitigate these adverse impacts and sustain crop growth, intermittent light irrigation will be necessary, the IMD stated. It added that the expected normal to below-normal maximum temperatures in Uttar Pradesh and Madhya Pradesh will likely limit the adverse effects of cold waves on field crops.

THE CENTRE has notified the appointment of Advocates Deepinder Singh Nalwa and Harmeet Singh Grewal as additional judges of the Punjab and Harvana High Court.

Union Law Minister Arun Ram Meghal posted on X, "In exercise of the power conferred by the Constitution of India, the President of India, after consultation with the Chief Justice of India, is pleased to appoint the following as High Court Judges / Additional Judges.'

The Supreme Court Collegium had first recommended the appointment of Nalwa and Grewal in October 2023, along with three other lawyers. However, their names were not cleared by the Centre.

The collegium reiterated their names in January 2024, and they have now been cleared.

In a resolution passed in November 2024, the collegium stated, "On April 21, 2023, the Chief Justice of the Punjab and Harvana High Court, in consultation with his two senior-most colleagues, recommended the elevation of the above advocates as judges of that High Court. The Chief Ministers and Governors of Punjab and Harvana have concurred with the recommendation."

Regarding Grewal's appointment, the collegium noted that "two of the three consultee judges have unanimously given a positive opinion on his suitability for appointment as a high court

On Nalwa, it stated, "All three consultee judges have unanimously given a positive opinion on his suitability for appointment as a judge of the high court... The candidate has extensive practice, as reflected in a substantial number of reported judgments delivered in cases in which he appeared or argued."

The two advocates are likely to be administered the oath as high court judges by Chief Justice Sheel Nagu before the weekend.

Abduction of dentist: Crime Branch Inspector among 7 cops booked

THE CBI has registered an FIR against seven policemen of Chandigarh for allegedly abducting a Chandigarh-based dentist in

The FIR has been registered against the then Inspector of Crime Branch Harinder Sekhon, Sub-Inspector Suresh Kumar, Assistant Sub-Inspector Aimer Singh, Head Constable Anil

The FIR against all accused persons under Section 365 (kidnapping or abducting someone with the intent to confine them wrongfully and secretly) read with 34 (acts done by several persons in furtherance of common intention) of the Indian Penal Code has been registered nearly six months after the Supreme Court had directed the CBI to con-

duct a preliminary probe into the

alleged abduction of the dentist,

Dr Mohit Dhawan, by Chandigarh Police personnel to prevent him from appearing in a court.

As per the CBI's FIR, a Preliminary Enquiry (PE) was registered at CBI. ACB. Chandigarh on August 29, 2024 against unknown officials of Chandigarh Police and others in compliance with order dated August 6, 2024, of the Supreme Court.

According to the CBI, the inquiry has revealed that Dr Mohit Dhawan is a dentist, and runs a dental care clinic at his residence in Sector 21. Chandigarh, along

revealed by CBI that Chandigarh Police had registered a FIR No-76 in March 2018, FIR No-75 in September 2020 and FIR No-56 in October 2021, against Dr Mohit Dhawan at Sector-19, Chandigarh. In FIR No-56, Dr Dhawan was granted the concession of interim anticipatory bail on October 22, 2022 by Additional Sessions Judge. Chandigarh.

केंद्रीय जांच ब्यरो (सीबीआइ) ने दिल्ली परिवहन विभाग के छह अधिकारियों को भ्रष्टाचार और रिश्वत लेने के आरोप में गिरफ्तार किया है। अधिकारियों ने बुधवार को यह जानकारी दी।
